### **State of the Ontario Nonprofit Sector**



Ontario nonprofits are collectively experiencing stagnant and **declining financial resources** amidst **climbing demand**. **39%** assessed themselves at significant risk for **not existing** in the next three years.

**83%** saw an **increase in demand** for programs and services, a 7% increase over 2023.

**54%** reported **stagnant and declining revenue** while 84% reported an increase in expenses.

**31%** reported using their **reserve funds**, almost mirroring pandemic-era levels.




### **State of Food Banks Mississauga**



Massive increase in YOY food bank demand:

- **78%** increase in food bank visits
- **58%** increase in food bank visitors





- Lack of provincial or federal funding for food banks or for those facing food insecurity
- No room for cost cutting without impact to programs and services
- Shortfalls in fundraising (2% revenue increase vs. 78% increase in demand)



Over the last year, Food Banks Mississauga has attempted to keep up with with rising demand, reaching a higher proportion of those who need us.

By 2027, we estimate **over 100,000** Mississauga residents will rely on food banks, almost double our current numbers.

#### We Need Your Help

#### **November 18 Peel Region Budget Committee**

- 1. Increase the *Food Security Emergency Response Fund* from \$2M to \$3.6M, commensurate with +78% YOY in food bank demand
- 2. Ensure a robust and transparent *Food Security Emergency Response Fund* application and allocation process for equitable fund distribution
