

Summary of Actions to Revoke the Former Region of Peel Official Plan (ROP)

As part of the update to Mississauga’s Official Plan under subsection 26(1) of the *Planning Act*, and to bring the Official Plan into consistency with the Provincial Policy Statement (PPS) 2024, the former Region of Peel Official Plan (ROP), as it applies to areas within the City, will be integrated into the new Mississauga Official Plan 2051 and the document will be subsequently revoked in accordance with subsection 70.13 (2) of the *Planning Act*.

The table below includes a summary of how each section of the ROP will be addressed during the integration and revocation process. Many factors are taken into effect in addressing these sections, including:

- 1- Amendments required as part of the consistency to the PPS2024.
- 2- Transitioning of planning responsibilities post July 1, 2024, as per Bill23, More Homes Built Faster Act, 2022.
- 3- Eliminating redundancies and streamlining the policy framework.
