## Subject

**Request to Alter a Heritage Designated Property at 40 Stavebank Road (Ward 1)**

## Recommendation

That the request to alter the heritage designated property at 40 Stavebank Road (Ward 1), as outlined in the Corporate Report dated November 28, 2024 from the Commissioner of Community Services be approved.

## Executive Summary

- The subject property is designated under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act.
- Section 33 of the Act states that Council permission is required to alter the property.
- Proposal is to instal a sign at the entrance to the property.
- Sign will be installed on the southeast corner of the property.

## Background

Council designated the Port Credit Memorial Arena at the subject property under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act (OHA) on October 12, 2011 per section 33 of the OHA, Council permission is required to alter the property.

## Comments

The City proposes to install a sign at the main entrance to the Port Credit Memorial Arena on the southeast corner of the property. The sign will stand 6.6 feet tall and be constructed out of aluminum with vinyl graphics. It will be installed on a concrete base. See appendix 1 for more details. As this sign will not have a negative impact on the designated property staff are recommending the project be approved.

## Financial Impact

There are no financial implications resulting from the recommendation of this report.

## Conclusion

The City proposes to install a sign on the southeast side of the property. The proposal would not negatively impact the property and should therefore be approved.
