# Increasing Administrative Parking Penalties


### **Current State**

- The following Schedules of the Administrative Penalty By-law 0282-2013 include 119 penalty amounts that range from \$30 \$400:
  - Schedule A, Designated By-Law Provisions Traffic By-Law 0555-2000;
  - Schedule A-1, Designated By-Law Provisions Traffic By-Law 0555-2000 Lakefront Increased Penalty Zone;
  - Schedule B, Designated By-Law Provisions Fire Route By-Law 0216-2023; and,
  - Schedule D, Designated By-Law Provisions Accessible Parking By-Law 0010-2016.
- Schedule A-1 was approved by Council in 2021, whereas, Schedules A, B, and D have not been reviewed or changed since 2016.



## **Current State**

- Parking service requests and tickets issuance have been increasing since 2021.
  - Enforcement received 182,096 parking service requests and issued 208,433 parking penalties in 2024. This exceeded 2023 numbers, which already surpassed the previous two years.





## **Jurisdictional Comparison**

- Staff reviewed parking penalties from five comparable jurisdictions: Toronto, Brampton, Ottawa, Hamilton, and Vaughan.
- Mississauga parking penalties were \$25 lower, on average, and had a 38% median percentage difference when compared to average jurisdictional amounts.
- Toronto recently increased penalties for 123 offences on August 1, 2024.
  Examples of their increases include:
  - parking without paying at a parking meter (increase from \$30 to \$50);
  - o parking a prohibited vehicle on a bicycle path (increase from \$60 to \$200); and,
  - parking within 3 metres of a fire hydrant (increase from \$100 to \$125).

## Recommended Increase (Schedule A)

- Staff recommend an across-the-board percentage increase to all parking penalties in Schedule A of the Administrative Penalty By-law 0282-2013, with an additional:
  - o \$10 increase to penalties identified as (or related to) the City's top parking offences.
  - \$50 to offences as they relate to public safety.
- The proposed increases will result in an average \$28 increase to current parking penalties outlined in Schedule A and will enable the City to better align with the penalty amounts of comparable jurisdictions.

## **Top Ticketed & Public Safety Parking Offences**

Parking offences related to the top issued tickets over the past four years will include an additional increase of \$10.

Parking offences related to public safety will include an additional increase of \$50.

#### **Top Ticketed Offences**

Parking vehicle on private property without owner's consent

Parking a vehicle on a highway between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. during prohibited period contrary to By-law

Parking a vehicle in parking space governed by a parking machine without clearly displaying receipt

Parking vehicle in prohibited area

Parking vehicle longer than five hours

#### **Public Safety Offences**

Parking/stopping as it relates to obstructing

Parking/stopping as it relates to fire hydrants

Parking/stopping as it relates school zones

Parking/stopping as it relates to heavy vehicles

Parking/stopping as it relates to bicycle lanes

## Recommended Increase (Multiple Schedules)

- Staff also recommend increasing:
  - All penalties in Schedule A-1 (Lakefront Increased Penalty Zone) from \$100 to \$150;
  - All penalties in Schedule B (Fire Route) from \$175 to \$225; and.
  - All penalties in Schedule D (Accessible Parking) from \$400 to \$450.
- The recommended \$50 increase to these Schedules' penalties aligns with the approach taken to penalties with heightened public safety concerns in Schedule A.



## **Implementation**

- The implementation date for the increased penalties is April 1, 2025.
- Leading up to implementation, staff will be:

Completing by-law amendments

Updating ticket issuance systems

Updating customer service knowledge bases

Conducting an education and awareness campaign about parking rules and penalty increases

## **Appendix 1: New Parking Offence Amounts - Examples**

| Penalty  | Current<br>Penalty | ATB %<br>Increase | Additional<br>Increase | New Fee |
|--|--------------------|-------------------|------------------------|---------|
| Parking vehicle in permit parking area without displaying a permit                 | \$30               | \$10              | -                      | \$40    |
| Parking vehicle within 5 metres of intersection                                    | \$50               | \$20              | -                      | \$70    |
| Parking vehicle longer than five hours   | \$35               | \$15              | \$10                   | \$60    |
| Parking vehicle on highway between 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. during prohibited period | \$40               | \$15              | \$10                   | \$65    |
| Parking vehicle within 3 metres of a fire hydrant                                  | \$50               | \$20              | \$50                   | \$120   |
| Parking heavy vehicle within 3 metres of a fire hydrant                            | \$125              | \$50              | \$50                   | \$225   |
| Parking/standing/stopping vehicle in a bicycle lane                                | \$55               | \$25              | \$50                   | \$130   |
