About MFEC

- Non-profit, charitable organization
- Helping and advocating for children with special needs, supporting **youth mental health problems** after COVID
- Funding **music therapy** treatment year round for **children with autism and developmental disabilities**, from kindergarten to high school
- Running long-term programs in **30 schools across 6 cities** in Ontario without any federal or provincial funding

Youth Team

- Founded and run by youth from Mississauga
- 100% full time student volunteers
- Program runs at **an average cost of \$1/day/child**, to provide continuous, year-round music therapy for a child with special needs, made possible by **250+ full- time student volunteers**



Financials

- No administrative expenses or salary as all members are volunteering
- No operating expenses as all programs are delivered on campus, during school hours to ensure accessibility
- 99% of funds go directly to music therapists
- How we fundraise
 - Kids make crafts by hand and sell them at local events
 - Apply to grants (provincial, federal, municipal, corporate)
 - Word-of-mouth & generous donations

Impact

We grew from serving 12 to 30 schools in 1 year. In Mississauga alone, we grew from 1 to 6 schools. This includes:

- **Dolphin Sr PS**
- **Huntington Ridge PS**

Due to lack of funding, we have had to place ErinOakKids and multiple schools on the waiting list.



Dolphin Sr PS

- **Streetsville** neighbourhood
- First school we started
- **Strong partnership** with school leaders and teachers and the community
- Witness firsthand the positive impacts from middle school entry to graduation
- Can **compile meaningful data** for evaluation



Huntington Ridge PS

- **East Credit** neighbourhood
- Population: **64% immigrants; 50% not graduated from post-secondary**
- Even with extremely cost-effective model and partnership with therapists, **program's need outmatches what we're able to provide**
- Needs for 2 classes and therefore split their 1hr/week into two (we're only able to provide 30 mins of programming/week for students)



Our Ask

- Funding
 - **\$10,000 Community Grant** will be a big confidence booster for our team, knowing the city supports what we do
 - **Potential for multi-year grant** next cycle gives some certainty in budgeting and a leg up in our fundraising initiatives during summer vacation
- Mentorship/ Support
 - Financial governance and operating procedures
 - Rigor of evaluation techniques
