

A by-law to repeal Community Benefits Charges
By-law 0134-2022

WHEREAS on June 22, 2022, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Mississauga passed By-law 0134-2022, being a by-law that imposes community benefits charges pursuant to section 37 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13 (“Community Benefits Charges By-law”);


AND WHEREAS on January 29, 2025 City Council passed Resolution 0015-2025 which approved the Mayor’s Housing Task Force Motion, including the direction to repeal the Community Benefits Charges By-law, effective the day following notice from the Ontario Land Tribunal that all appeals have been withdrawn or dismissed;

AND WHEREAS on February 6, 2025 the Ontario Land Tribunal issued notice that all appeals of the City’s Community Benefits Charges By-Law have been withdrawn;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Mississauga, ENACTS as follows:

1. That By-law 0134-2022 is hereby repealed.
2. This By-law is deemed to have come into force on February 7, 2025, being the day following notice from the Ontario Land Tribunal that all appeals have been withdrawn.
