Laura Zeglen, Active Transportation Coordinator provided an overview of the Safety audit walks highlighting updates for this year on Mississauga school walking routes program, such as launch events, promotion of active school program and next steps.

In response to Councillor Fonseca, L. Zeglen explained that the standards for the program vary by school and school board, with audits focusing on parking and stopping bylaws, as well as site inspections to identify potential issues. L. Zeglen clarified that raised crossings are not part of the current audit criteria but could be considered if needed and noted that up to 8 schools are prioritized based on proximity, with others considered for future campaigns based on demographics.
