A by-law to amend Marina By-law 0187-2005

WHEREAS subsection 11(3)(5) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws regarding culture, parks, recreation and heritage;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga enacted Marina By-law 0187-2005 on May 25, 2005;

AND WHEREAS the City's Council Procedure By-law 0044-2022, as amended, provides under section 94.2 that the City Clerk is authorized to submit By-laws directly to Council for enactment without the need for a Corporate Report in order to update references to City staff position titles, departments or divisions that have changed as a result of any administrative restructuring or re-organization at the City;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga, ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That the Marina By-law 0187-2005 is hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) by deleting the definition of "Commissioner" in Section 1 and replacing it with the following:

"Commissioner" means the Commissioner of Community Services or their designate;

(b) by deleting the definition of "Manager" in Section 1 and replacing it with the following:

"Manager" means the Manager, Park Services, or their designate;

(c) by deleting the definition of "Marina Staff" in Section 1 and replacing it with the following:

"Marina Staff" means a permanent, full-time employee in the Parks, Forestry and Environment Division of the Corporation;
