

A by-law to amend Heritage Grant  
By-law 0184-2007, as amended

WHEREAS subsection 11(3)(5) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws regarding heritage;

AND WHEREAS sections 39(1) and 45 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18 (the “Act”), authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws providing for the making of a grant to an owner of property designated under Part IV of the Act or located in a Heritage Conservation District designated under Part V of the Act for the purpose of paying for the whole or any part of the cost of alteration of such property on such terms and conditions as Council may prescribe;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga enacted Heritage Grant By-law 0184-2007, as amended, on May 9, 2007;


AND WHEREAS the City’s Council Procedure By-law 0044-2022, as amended, provides under section 94.2 that the City Clerk is authorized to submit By-laws directly to Council for enactment without the need for a Corporate Report in order to update references to City staff position titles, departments or divisions that have changed as a result of any administrative restructuring or re-organization at the City;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga, ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That the Heritage Grant By-law 0184-2007, as amended, is hereby further amended by deleting the definition of “**Director**” in Section 2(d) and replacing it with the following:

“**Director**” shall mean the City’s Director, Parks, Forestry and Environment Division or their designate;
