

A by-law to amend Heritage By-law  
0078-2018, as amended

WHEREAS subsection 11(3)(5) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws regarding heritage;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga enacted Heritage By-law 0078-2018, as amended, on April 25, 2018;

AND WHEREAS the City’s Council Procedure By-law 0044-2022, as amended, provides under section 94.2 that the City Clerk is authorized to submit By-laws directly to Council for enactment without the need for a Corporate Report in order to update references to City staff position titles, departments or divisions that have changed as a result of any administrative restructuring or re-organization at the City;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga, ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That the Heritage By-law 0078-2018, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:
  - (a) by deleting the definition of “Director” in subsection 2(8) and replacing it with the following:


“Director” means the City’s Director, Parks, Forestry and Environment Division or their designate;
  - (b) by deleting subsection 26(1) and replacing it with the following:

26(1) Director, Parks, Forestry and Environment Division or their designate;
  - (c) by deleting subsection 26(2) and replacing it with the following:

26(2) Manager, Indigenous Relations, Heritage & Museums;
  - (d) by deleting subsection 26(3) and replacing it with the following:

26(3) Manager, Culture Planning;
