

A by-law to amend Licensing Administrative  
Penalty By-law 0135-2014, as amended, to  
introduce administrative penalties for  
contraventions of the Fence  
By-law 0397-1978

WHEREAS sections 8, 9 and 11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, (“*Municipal Act, 2001*”) authorize The Corporation of the City of Mississauga (the “City”) to pass by-laws necessary or desirable for municipal purposes;

AND WHEREAS section 434.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a municipality may require a person, subject to such conditions as the municipality considers appropriate, to pay an administrative penalty if the municipality is satisfied that the person has failed to comply with a by-law of the municipality passed under the Act;

AND WHEREAS on June 11, 2014, the Council of the City enacted Licensing Administrative Penalty By-law 0135-2014, as amended, to designate the City’s licensing by-laws, or portions of those by-laws, to be applicable to the administrative penalty system established through said by-law;

AND WHEREAS on February 11, 2026, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga passed Resolution \_\_\_\_\_ approving General Committee Recommendation \_\_\_\_\_ to amend Licensing Administrative Penalty By-law 0135-2014, as amended, to designate the Fence By-law 0397-1978 and to introduce administrative penalties for contraventions of the Fence By-law 0397-1978;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga ENACTS as follows:

1. That Licensing Administrative Penalty By-law 0135-2014, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the following to Schedule “B”:

**FENCE BY-LAW 0397-1978, AS AMENDED**

1. For the purposes of section 3 of this By-law, Column 1 in the following table lists the provisions in the Fence By-law 0397-1978, as amended, that are hereby designated.
2. Column 2 in the following table sets out the short form wording to be used in a Penalty Notice for the contravention of the designated provisions listed in Column 1.
3. Column 3 in the following table sets out the Administrative Penalty amounts that are payable for contraventions of the designated provisions listed in Column 1.

1	Subsection 5(1)	Erect/cause to be erected a fence higher than 2 m above effective ground level in a yard on land used for residential/commercial purposes	\$305.00

2	Subsection 6(2)(a)	Erect/cause to be erected a fence of solid type construction higher than 1 m above effective ground level within 4.5 m of the nearest streetline, in a front yard on land used for residential/commercial purposes	\$305.00
3	Subsection 6(2)(b)	Erect/cause to be erected a fence of open construction higher than 1.5 m above effective ground level within 4.5 m of the nearest streetline, in a front yard on land used for residential/commercial purposes	\$305.00
4	Subsection 6(2)(b)	Maintain/allow a fence of open type construction to grow higher than 1.5 m above effective ground level within 4.5 m of the nearest streetline, in a front yard on land used for residential/commercial purposes	\$305.00
5	Subsection 7(1)	Erect/cause to be erected privacy screen on residential/commercial land	\$305.00
6	Section 8	Erect/cause to be erected a fence of closed construction higher than 1 m above effective ground level within a sight triangle	\$305.00
7	Section 8	Erect/cause to be erected a fence/privacy screen higher than 1 m above effective ground level within a sight triangle that obstructs the visibility of motorists and pedestrians	\$305.00
8	Section 8	Maintain/allow a fence/privacy screen to grow higher than 1 m above effective ground level within a sight triangle that obstructs the visibility of motorists and pedestrians	\$305.00
9	Section 9	Erect/cause to be erected a fence/privacy screen on City lands without authorization from Council	\$305.00
10	Section 9	Erect/cause to be erected a fence/privacy screen on a highway/road allowance without authorization of Council	\$305.00
11	Section 9	Erect/cause to be erected a fence/privacy screen on City right-of-way/easement without authorization of Council	\$305.00
12	Subsection 11(1)	Erect/cause to be erected a fence of hazardous material on land used for residential purposes	\$305.00
13	Subsection 11(1)	Erect/cause to be erected a fence of hazardous material along a highway adjacent to residential land	\$305.00
14	Subsection 12(1)	Erect/cause to be erected an electrical fence on any land	\$305.00
15	Section 12.1	Fail to erect/cause to be erected golf ball containment netting or fence of chain link construction	\$305.00
16	Subsection 14.1(4)	Prevent, hinder, or obstruct, or attempt to hinder or obstruct, an Officer who is lawfully exercising a power or performing a duty under the by-law	\$305.00
17	Subsection 14.1(8)	Fail to comply with order	\$305.00

2. That this by-law shall come into force on April 6, 2026.
