Hello,

I'm a Lime rider in Mississauga, and I'm writing to ask you to keep our micromobility program running.

As a young adult living in this city, access to Lime has completely transformed how I get around. Last year alone, I rode well over 1,200 km using the service. I rely on these devices for everything from commuting to the gym to running daily errands across the city. Every one of those kilometres represents a car trip I did not have to take, which helps reduce traffic congestion and saves me a significant amount on gas and parking.

Beyond the practicality, I appreciate being able to stay active and spend time outside while getting things done. Having an affordable and accessible transportation option that supports the transit goals of a modern city makes Mississauga feel much more connected.

I truly believe the City should be doing more to expand accessible transportation opportunities for everyone, rather than centering so much of its planning around cars. We should be focusing on creating more diverse ways for people to safely reach services, businesses, and local destinations across Mississauga. Removing existing options is a step backward. We need a city built for people and mobility, not just for through-traffic.

Please vote against a ban on e-scooters. Let's keep Mississauga moving in the right direction by supporting more ways to get around, not fewer.
