- Mississauga City Hall had its official opening on July 18, 1987
- Mississauga City Hall remains a key landmark in the City for residents, staff and community to come together and celebrate key milestones.
- As the City recently celebrated it's 50th Anniversary, we now have another key milestone coming, City Hall 40th Anniversary in 2027.
- Staff, Community and Council can all work together to create a “Doors Open Mississauga” theme event in which we celebrate City Hall history and key milestone events such as Civil Ceremonies in a renovated Chapel, Clock Tower Tours and Community Events at Celebration Square all leading up to July 18, 2027

# City Hall - 40th Anniversary

- During the period of Doors Open City Hall, 40 Civil Ceremonies would be provided to the community in a newly design chapel.
- Chapel Rental Fees of Resident (\$105.78 and Non Resident \$108.89) and Civil Marriage Ceremony Fee of \$391.04 could be waived for 40 Civil Ceremonies during the celebration period for our community. (Similar to Toronto Doors Open at Old City Hall in 2025)
- A unique ceremony event for the 40 Civil Ceremonies could be held at CBanquet here on the 12th floor to showcase this milestone and celebration here at City Hall.

# City Hall - 40th Anniversary Clock Tower Tours

- During the 40th Anniversary Period, the City can open tours of the Clock Tower and have member of the public enjoy an unique experience to go up the clock tower. This experience was available in the 90's to members of the community during school trip visits at City Hall. The clock tower can be lit a different colour each night during the 40th Anniversary of City Hall.
