Dear Mayor Parrish:

I am pleased to inform you that the Capital Plan for the Corporation of the City of Mississauga (CP-001077) is approved in principle under the terms and conditions of the Government of Canada's Baseline Funding stream of the Canada Public Transit Fund (CPTF).

Federal funding of the Capital Plan under the Baseline Funding stream of the CPTF will be up to \$11,241,629, annually, which represents up to \$112,416,290, over 10 years starting in 2026-2027. With this approval in principle, eligible costs as determined under the terms and conditions of the CPTF and incurred as of the date of this letter will be eligible for federal reimbursement subject to the timely execution of a contribution agreement, and the submission and acceptance of individual Capital Plan Components. If a contribution agreement is not signed, the Government of Canada will not reimburse any costs incurred.

Program officials from my Department will be in contact with you soon to discuss the contribution agreement. Please carefully review the Annex attached to this letter, which contains important details about the conditions associated with this approval in principle.

The Government of Canada is committed to helping you make our communities more sustainable and to improve the quality of life for all residents. The Capital Plan for the Corporation of the City of Mississauga is an excellent example of the commitment and vision needed to make this a reality across our country, and the Government of Canada looks forward to the submission of Components under your Capital Plan.
