#### **Breakdown**

#### 75 organizations to receive funding:

- 63 applications recommended for funding in four streams
  - 6 new organizations recommended for funding
  - 4 new multi-year funding agreements
- 12 organizations moving into final year of multi-year funding



## **Application Process**

- Deadline for submission: October 16, 2020
- Applications reviewed for completeness
- Finance Staff provide analysis of the financial risk
- Peer Assessment/Grants Review Committee review and make recommendations based on a set of criteria

# Peer Assessor / Grants Review Committees

- Chosen by Council for a 4-year term
- Experience
  - Community leaders
  - Subject matter experts
  - Strong Mississauga connections
  - Varied backgrounds



#### **Culture Grant Criteria**

- Inter-cultural Reach
- Strengthening Culture in Mississauga / Identifying,
  Preserving and Celebrating Mississauga's Heritage
- Strengthening Governance
- Organizational Stability

## **Community Grant Criteria**

- Program / Service Merit
- Accessibility
- Effectiveness
- Accountability
- Demonstrated Need for Funding



#### **Stabilization Fund**

- Support for groups which may not have been able to access City funding and have been financial impacted during the pandemic
- Funding only available for 2021
- \$100,000 from unallocated grants budget
- Maximum grant of \$10,000



## **Small Project Matching Grant**

- Supports strengthening neighborhoods, increasing resident engagement and engagement in events and activities at the neighborhood level
- \$25,000 from unallocated grants budget
- Maximum grant of \$2,500



## **COVID-19 Impact**

- 2020 Funding was used for rent, paying staff, utilities, purchasing digital equipment and digital festivals and programing
- 2021 funding allocated based on programing and/or festivals taking place (in some form)
- Staff will provide an update to Council in the Spring
